**TOWER CONSTRUCTION NOTIFICATION SYSTEM  
(TCNS)**

*The TCNS is intended to advance the goal of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) to protect historic properties, including tribal religious and cultural sites, in an efficient and convenient manner that promotes the interests of both Tribes and the communications industry. Tribes indicate their geographic areas of interest by specifying the states or counties where they wish to be notified about proposed construction.*

# **TOWER CONSTRUCTION NOTIFICATION SYSTEM (TCNS)**

- **An on-line, password-protected system that notifies federally recognized American Indian Tribes and Alaska Native Villages (collectively, “Tribes”), Native Hawaiian Organizations (NHOs), and State Historic Preservation Officers (SHPOs) of proposed communications tower constructions in areas of interest designated by the recipients.**
- **Provides a means for Tribes, NHOs, and SHPOs to respond directly to the companies or entities providing notification as to whether they have concerns about the proposed tower construction.**

### Tower Construction Notification System (TCNS)

The Commission's TCNS works to increase communication with Indian Tribes and Native Hawaiian Organizations (NHOs) in the context of the review required by Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA). It also provides Tribes/NHOs and State Historic Preservation Officers with early notification of proposed towers in order to facilitate compliance with the Commission's rules, and streamline the review process for construction of towers and other Commission undertakings.

### Electronic Section-106 System (E-106)

The Commission's E-106 System may be used in completing the review process for proposed constructions of communications facilities under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA). E-106 is a voluntary system designed to save users time and resources by automating and expediting the exchange of information and correspondence in the Section 106 process.

### How the Systems Work

Tower construction notification allows companies to voluntarily submit notifications of proposed tower constructions to the FCC. The Commission subsequently provides this information to federally-recognized Indian Tribes, Native Hawaiian Organizations (NHOs), and State Historic Preservation Officers (SHPOs), and allows them to respond directly to the companies if they have concerns about a proposed construction.

The E-106 System enables the real-time referral of information and documented communication among all participating parties, including the FCC. Using the E-106 System, parties proposing to construct communications facilities can now electronically submit the FCC Form 620 or 621 (September 2008 edition) to the SHPO/THPOs using a secure website maintained by the FCC. The new online forms 620 and 621 are substantively the same as the old forms but have been reformatted to accommodate the electronic system. This system also provides electronic notice of the filing to the relevant State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO), federally recognized Indian Tribes, and other consulting parties, who will be able to access the filings pertinent to them using a secure password. SHPOs and consulting parties can also use the system to comment on filings and otherwise participate in the process, and to access each others' filings.

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) released a Declaratory Ruling (FCC 05-176) on October 6, 2005 clarifying portions of the Nationwide Programmatic Agreement (NPA). The clarification addressed situations where a federally recognized Indian Tribe (Indian Tribe) or Native Hawaiian Organization (NHO) has not responded to a TCNS notification, or to the applicant's and Commission's efforts to determine whether the Indian Tribe or NHO has an interest in participation in the review of the proposed project.

The Declaratory Ruling states that once a wireless provider or other tower applicant (applicant) has made two good faith efforts over 40 days to obtain a response from an Indian tribe or NHO about a proposed communications tower or antenna, the FCC will, upon notice from an applicant, send a letter and/or e-mail to the Indian tribe's or NHO's designated cultural resources representative, seeking an indication of whether the Indian tribe or NHO has an interest in participating in the review of the proposed facility. If the Indian tribe or NHO does not respond within 20 days of the FCC's letter and/or e-mail, which will be followed up by an attempted FCC telephone contact during the same 20-day period, it will be deemed to have no interest in the review of the proposed facility. At that point, the applicant will have fulfilled its obligations under the NPA, and the Indian Tribe or NHO will be deemed to have no interest in pre-construction review of the proposed project.

By this communication, we respectfully submit the Federal Communications Commission's (Commission) final request for you, as the designated representative of the Bridgeport Indian Colony for purposes of the Notification System (TCNS) to let us know whether your tribe has an interest in participating in pre-construction review of the proposed communications facilities listed in the table below for effects on historic properties. In particular, we request that you inform us and each party listed below (as indicated by the asterisk) within 30 calendar days of this communication whether historic properties of religious and cultural significance to your tribe may be affected by construction of the proposed communications facilities. Our records further indicate that neither you nor the Applicant has expressed a desire to engage in government-to-government consultation regarding the undertaking(s). In the event that you have already responded either to an Applicant or to the Commission, you do not need to respond again, and we apologize for the misunderstanding.

According to information provided to us by the Applicants, each Applicant listed below (or the Commission through TCNS) has made at least two reasonable and good faith attempts, consistent with the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) and the Commission's Rules, to contact you regarding construction of the proposed communications facilities. If you have not received such communications, please let us know. Nonetheless, we indicate that you or your tribe has provided us with a statement either of "interest" or of "no interest" regarding the proposed undertaking(s), and we are informed that the Applicant has received responses to our inquiries. We indicate that neither you nor your tribe has expressed a desire to engage in government-to-government consultation regarding the undertaking(s). In the event that you have already responded either to an Applicant or to the Commission, you do not need to respond again, and we apologize for the misunderstanding.

In order to fulfill our obligations under the NHPA, the Commission has instituted rules and procedures to ensure that we consult with any Federally recognized Indian Tribes, including Alaska Native Villages (collectively Tribes), and Native Hawaiian organizations (NHOs), that may affect religious and cultural significance to your tribe in connection with an undertaking. These procedures, as memorialized in the Nationwide Programmatic Agreement (NPA), initially require Applicants to identify and ensure that early contact is made with Tribes that may affect religious and cultural significance to affected historic properties (see Section IV.B and IV.C). As you know, your tribe has voluntarily entered information into TCNS regarding the geographic areas where such properties may exist.

The NPA requires Applicants to make initial contact with Tribes that may affect religious and cultural significance to a historic property that may be affected by an undertaking through TCNS or otherwise in accordance with each Tribe's or NHO's procedures. The NPA requires Applicants to afford these Tribes a reasonable period of time to respond, ordinarily 30 days (Section IV.F), and it advises Applicants to follow up in case a Tribe does not respond to a single attempt at communication (Section IV.F.5).
